




Spanning 2.85 miles along the ridge, the Hotshots Trail leads to the Observation Deck which overlooks the fatality site and Yarnell to the east.

As you walk along the trail, you'll encounter 19 granite plaques set into rock, each representing a fallen Hotshot. Along the way, you'll see benches, and additional interpretive signs that tell the story of wildland firefighters.

From there, the .75-mile Journey Trail leads down to a memorial located at the fatality site, where visitors can sit to pay their respects and reflect.

This 7-mile round-trip trail includes a 1,200 foot elevation gain and a 5-8% grade. Please plan for a 4-hour plus round-trip hike.





To accommodate as many visitors as possible, Arizona State Parks is providing shuttle service from Yarnell to the park entrance. Shuttles will run from Wednesday, November 30 - Sunday, December 4 from 7am.- 4:00pm. and will pick-up and drop-off on the half-hour.

DRIVING FROM PHOENIX:

Take I-17 north to Carefree Highway (74) (west) Head west on US 60 to Wickenburg (north) Take Highway 93 towards Congress (north) Take Highway 89 (White Spar Hwy.) to Yarnell

DRIVING FROM PRESCOTT:

Take Highway 89 (White Spar Hwy.) south to Yarnell
